**YOU AND YOUR HANDICAP**

The active season in Washington State for posting scores into the GHIN Handicap System ends on 11/22/01. Scores made in an area where an inactive season has been declared shall not be accepted for handicap purposes. Handicap Indexes are not revised during the inactive season.

Scores made in an area observing an active season (e. g. Arizona in December) must be posted for handicap purposes even if they are made during the time when the area where the golfer posts scores is in the inactive season. Scores must be posted at the player's golf club no later than the beginning of the new active season in March 2002 or as soon as practical. All scores from active season areas shall be posted, or, if there are more than 20, then the last 20 plus any eligible tournament scores shall be posted.

**G.S.W.P.G.A.**

**RULE OF THE MONTH**

6-6 Scoring in Stroke Play.

b. Signing and Returning Card. After the completion of the round, the competitor should check their score for each hole and settle any doubtful points with the Committee. She shall ensure that the marker has signed the card, countersign the card herself and return it to the Committee as soon as possible.

d. Wrong Score for Hole. The competitor is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole on her card. If she returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken, she shall be disqualified. If the score for any hole is higher than actual, the score as returned shall stand.

Always check your score card hole for hole with the person keeping your score to avoid any chance of disqualification.
