**Local Rules**

Whichever course you might find yourself playing, remember to read the local rules, which should be printed on the score card.

Last year in a tournament I had the unfortunate mishap of getting my ball caught up in one of the trees that designate 150 yards. With some discussion amongst my foursome and the help of a marshal that happened by at the right time, it was determined that I was able to take a one club length relief without penalty. Noted on the back of the Riverbend score card is Relief/Free Drop from all yardage markers, ground under repair, french drains, staked trees, flower beds, paved card paths and service roads.

Keep in mind, this rule may not apply at another golf course. In fact another course may have a whole set of its own rules.
