## Post where you play! Says who?...

From the Washington State Golf Assn website: "A convenience of GHIN is being able to post where you play. GHIN associations throughout the nation share a common database that allow you to post where you play and have that score routed back to your home club." From the Arizona Golf Assn site: "We always recommend that you post where you play!" From the Golf Club of New Jersey: "Post Where You Play! – This is the preferred method for score posting." From the Georgia State Golf Assn website: "Post where you play.....remember your GHIN number!" "Post Where You Play! is a motto of the Northern California GA."

From RLGA member, Cindy Banks:

Posting Away Scores: When playing another course and you would like to post your score, locate their computer and

1. Press guest score posting
2. Enter your ghin number
3. Enter your last name (sometimes this step is automatic)
4. Enter gender, and number of holes played
5. Enter which tees you played
6. Enter adjusted score
7. Recheck your information then press the Post button. You have successfully posted where you played and a message surfaces where you are told your score will be routed to your home club and the score will appear on the next revision.
