**RLGA is joining TWGA in 2010** <http://twga.org>. Tacoma Women's Golf Association (TWGA) invited RLGA membership into their final 2009 event on August 31 at the Home Course. You should have received a broadcast E-mail notifying you of this invitation. Cathy Kay, Mary Ryan, Sheila Locke, Kellie Molzon and Ok Yun Lim accepted. The Home Course was in pristine condition. At TWGA events players have the option of paying \$2.00 to enter the casino hole race. A chalk circle is drawn 12 feet around the pin at a par three hole. Anyone who lands inside the hole splits the casino pot. Sheila Locke was one of eight of the 140 participants who landed inside that circle and received \$21.00 cash money. A TWGA regular said the 140 participants was a huge event for them. (144 is a full field with two foursomes starting at each hole.)

Your RLGA membership gains you entry into state (WSWPLA) events, city (GSWPGA) events and in 2010 the TWGA. Enjoy the Pierce and Thurston county courses in 2010 by entering TWGA sweeps. The level of competition in the TWGA is comparable with both city and state. TWGA start times are always shotgun and there is usually a specially priced lunch menu for the entrants.

## Unplayable... What can be done?

An unplayable lie gives a player 3 options, each carries a one stroke penalty.

A) Play from the original spot (as near as can be determined)

B) Drop a ball behind the point where the unplayable ball lay, keeping that point between the hole and the spot where the ball is dropped. You can go back as far as you want.

C) Drop a ball within two club lengths of where the ball lay, no closer to the hole.

-It is solely up to a player to decide if her ball is unplayable, except.....

-A ball in a water hazard cannot be deemed unplayable.

-If you have an unplayable lie in a bunker, and you choose option B or C, you must drop in the bunker.

-Check out all your options before you choose one, because once you have dropped, the ball is in play, even if it rolls back to its original unplayable condition.

Unlike other drop situations, you are not entitled to complete relief or a redrop if you did not get relief on the first drop and you can't choose option A anymore either.

-You must be able to definitively identify your ball in order to elect either option B or C (for example, if you think your ball is in a tree, you must be able to identify it as yours).

-Another penalty stroke would be assessed if an additional option (B or C) was chosen.

- If a dropped ball rolls closer to the hole, it must be redropped (without additional penalty).
