It wasn't cold but it was raining the first morning of the 3 day City Championship at Lake Wilderness. We gathered in the parking lot, unfolding our push carts, popping open our umbrellas and saying good morning to those we knew and didn't know. There were four ladies participating from the Riverbend Club and all were playing in the last three tee times scheduled for day one. By hole number four, the umbrellas were put away, coats and sweaters were being peeled off and it was a great day for golf. At the end of round one, when all the cards were turned in, results showed Mary Ryan in the lead, followed by Cathy Kay in 2nd, and Ok Yun Lim not far behind. The fourth Riverbend gal was in the bar drinking a beer.

Day two began with cloudy skies but no rain and a lot of hope for another great round or a much improved round. Oks drive left her with about 120 yards to the pin. She hit a good shot, landing it on the top of the hill but just short of the green. Cathy, who hit her best drive of the day, was left with about 90 yards to the pin. Her favorite distance. CHAPMAN TOURNAMENT – MIXED OR NOT

Sunday, September 12, 2010 – 8:30 AM

The RLGA Club member will choose a male or female to be their partner just so long as they have an established handicap. In a Chapman, both players tee off from their respective tees (Men will play from the White tees and Women from the Red tees). Each player goes to the other player's ball and takes a second shot. After the second shot, the team chooses which ball they will complete the hole with and whoever's turn it is on that ball, that player takes their (the teams) third shot. The team continues alternating shots on one ball until it is holed out.
